



Burn Permit Checklist

The following items are required and submittals must be complete before accepted for review.

- ❑ **Completed Town of Sahuarita Permit Application**
 - ❑ Permit application can be found online at <http://sahuaritaaz.gov/buildingsafety>
 - ❑ Submittals may be emailed to builddapps@sahuaritaaz.gov
 - ❑ Sign and date the application
 - ❑ If applicant is not the property owner, a **copy of the agreement** between the owner and the agent or a **signed letter** from the property owner stating that the applicant is an authorized agent will be required
- ❑ **2 Copies of Site Plan** (minimum 8½ x 11)
 - ❑ Show the location of the burn area with dimensions from surrounding structures and property lines
 - ❑ Open burning must be located greater than 50 feet from any structure
- ❑ **1 Copy of Pima County Department of Environmental Quality (PDEQ) Burn Permit**

Note:

- There is no permit fee and no inspection required.
- A burn permit is not required for fires that are used only for cooking food, providing warmth for human beings, recreational purposes, branding of animals, orchard heaters, and the proper disposal of flags.
- Burning garbage is illegal and the smoke released can cause severe health problems and release dangerous chemicals into the air.
