The programs include Adult Day Services (activities and care for older adults and respite for their caregivers), Behavioral Health Services (in-home or in-office counseling for teens through adults), the Casa Community Center (Senior Lunch, lifelong learning programs, daytrips and social activities) and Los Niños del Valle Preschool and Child Care (ages 18 mo-5 yr with a summer program for ages 5-8). Intergenerational activities take place between child care and adult program participants.

Community Food Bank (CFB) – Green Valley and Amado, 250 Continental Rd., #101, Green Valley, AZ 85614

Our vision is a Healthy, Hunger-free community. We provide food to those in need under The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP) which provides low-income individuals and households with surplus commodities. The Community Food Bank, with assistance from volunteers, combines donated items, purchased food, and USDA commodities using a client choice system. Clients receive canned vegetables, canned tomato product, soup, canned fruit or juice, rice, beans, cereal, mac & cheese, and canned meat. Other items such as bread, fresh produce, milk and eggs are provided if available. To receive emergency food, clients will complete a one page application and self-declare that they meet the income guidelines. In addition clients will be asked to provide their name, date of birth, number of people in household, date of birth for each person in household, a photo ID and proof of address.

The Sahuarita Food Bank's mission is that "No One Should be Hungry. We provide nutritious food to low-income* community residents within Pima County. The Sahuarita Food Bank is open on Thursdays from 3 pm-5 pm and Saturdays from 10 am-12 noon. We distribute government TEFAP boxes (The Emergency Food Assistance Program), as well as meat; eggs; milk; bread; canned meat; pasta and sauce; rice; beans; and/or other canned vegetables and fruits. We also give our clients a choice of a variety of fresh produce. The Sahuarita Food Bank provides services to our clients twice a month, if they so Choose. Sahuarita Food Bank also serves 196 students with emergency food for the weekend through the Feeding America BackPack Program.

The Salvation Army of Green Valley is a non-profit Social Service Center. We impact the community by helping those in need. Our main function is assistance with past due or disconnected utility bills. We help with gas, electric, water, propane, and utility deposits for those who are low income, disabled, or unemployed. During summer, we host a "Kids Care Fair". Low income families are provided a back pack full of school supplies, a uniform shirt, and a new pair of shoes for each child in grade K-12.

In November and December we offer a communal, hot home cooked meal on Thanksgiving and Christmas to anyone who is spending the holiday alone, or cannot afford a meal of their own.

In December we have our angel tree program where low income families are given assistance with TOYS for their children. Each child has their own angel tree tag that is hung on a Christmas tree in various businesses around town. Each angel tree tag is shopped for personally by generous people in our community.
