

**SAHUARITA ORDINANCE NO. 2024-173**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAHUARITA, PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AMENDING TITLE 2, ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL BY AMENDING CHAPTER 2.20, TOWN OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES, BY AMENDING SECTION 2.20.020, TOWN OFFICERS TO INCLUDE THE ASSISTANT TOWN MANAGER AS AN OFFICERS OF THE TOWN; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Sahuarita has determined it is in the Town's best interest to revise the Town Code Title 2, Administration and Personnel by amending Chapter 2.20, Town Officers and Employees, by amending Section 2.20.020, Town Officers, to include the Assistant Town Manager as an officer of the Town; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Sahuarita, Arizona, as follows:

**Section 1.** The Town of Sahuarita Municipal Code is hereby amended by amending Title 2 Administration and Personnel by amending Chapter 2.20 Town Officers and Employees, by amending Section 2.20.020 Town Officers To include the Assistant Town Manager as an officer of the Town; to read follows (new text in **BOLD/ALL CAPS**):

**2.20.020 Town officers.**

In addition to the members of the council, the officers of the town shall be the town manager/town marshal, **ASSISTANT TOWN MANAGER**, town attorney, town clerk, finance director, and town engineer. Each such officer shall be bonded as provided in A.R.S. § 9-302.

\* \* \*

**Section 2.** The various Town officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this Ordinance.

**Section 3.** All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance or any part of the Code adopted herein by reference are hereby repealed.

**Section 4.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance or any part of the Code adopted herein by reference is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

**Section 5.** Pursuant to A.R.S. § 19-142, this Ordinance shall become operative 30 days after its passage.
