

SAHUARITA ORDINANCE NO. 2024-174

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAHUARITA, PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE SAHUARITA TOWN CODE, BY AMENDING THE FOLLOWING CHAPTERS RELATED TO THE ADOPTION OF FEES BY THE TOWN: CHAPTER 3.10 (FEE SCHEDULE), SECTIONS 3.10.030 (ADMINISTRATIVE FEES); 3.10.140 (MISCELLANEOUS FEES); 3.10.160 (POLICE DEPARTMENT ADMINISTRATIVE FEES); 3.10.170 (MUNICIPAL COURT FEES); AND 3.10.180 (DOG LICENSE FEES); PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

WHEREAS, the Town of Sahuarita, Arizona (the “Town”) desires to amend the Town’s Municipal Code, pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes § 9-499.15, to clarify Council’s responsibility in the adoption of fees by various departments through the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to update the Sahuarita Town Code, by amending Chapter 3.10 (Fee Schedule), Sections 3.10.030 (Administrative Fees); 3.10.140 (Miscellaneous Fees); 3.10.160 (Police Department Administrative Fees); 3.10.170 (Municipal Court Fees); and 3.10.180 (Dog License Fees) by adoption of the “The June 2024 Amendments to Chapter 3.10 (Fee Schedule) of the Sahuarita Town Code”,(additions in **BOLD/ALL CAPS**; deletions in ~~strikeout~~), Exhibit “A,” to this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Sahuarita, Arizona, as follows:

- Section 1.** The recitals above are hereby incorporated as if fully set forth herein.
- Section 2.** The various Town officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this Ordinance.
- Section 3.** All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance or any part of the Code adopted herein by reference are hereby repealed.
- Section 4.** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance or any part of the Code adopted herein by reference is, for any reason, held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.
- Section 5.** Pursuant to A.R.S. § 19-142, this Ordinance shall become operative 30 days after its passage.
