Sewer Rate Changes Effective January 1, 2019



All customers – residential and general commercial* customers – will see rate changes beginning with their February 2019 sewer bill:

- **Monthly base fee increase of \$2.37**, from \$16.60 to \$18.97
- **Monthly user consumption fee rate increase of \$0.27 Kgal** (per thousand gallons), from \$8.12 to \$8.39. Remember that your monthly user volume fee is reduced with a 20% irrigation credit.

The Sahuarita Town Council approved rate changes on November 13, 2017, based upon a financial plan and rate study completed by an independent consultant. These rate changes will promote financial stability of the Wastewater Utility and ensures that we continue to meet operational and environmental standards today and in the future.

* Monthly user consumption fee increases will vary among 16 specific commercial entities.

3 Easy Ways to Protect Our Environment and Infrastructure

1. Dispose of trash properly. Loose trash can wash into the drainage system and impact wildlife and our views.
2. Don't flush cleaning wipes, makeup wipes, personal wipes or baby wipes down the toilet – even if labeled 'flushable.' They clog up wastewater facilities.
3. Help to prevent fires by being a responsible smoker. Please watch where ash goes, fully extinguish your cigarette or cigar and dispose of butts in a proper container.
