WHY IS IT IMPORTANT TO ME?

Responding to the census affects the amount of funding your community receives, how your community plans for the future, and your representation in government. The 2020 Census will be used to:

- Ensure public services and funding for schools, hospitals, and fire departments.
- Plan new businesses and neighborhoods.
- Determine how many seats your state is allocated in the House of Representatives.

HOW CAN I RESPOND?

In 2020, for the first time ever, the U.S. Census Bureau will accept responses online, but you can still respond by phone or mail if you prefer.

WHAT INFORMATION WILL BE REQUESTED?

The census will collect information about the people living in your household. You should count everyone who is living in your household on April 1, 2020.

The Census Bureau will NOT ask for:

- Social Security numbers.
- Bank or credit card account numbers.
- Money or donations.
- Anything on behalf of a political party.

WILL MY INFORMATION BE KEPT CONFIDENTIAL?

Strict federal law protects your census responses. It is against the law for any Census Bureau employee to disclose or publish any census information that identifies an individual. Census Bureau employees take a lifelong pledge of confidentiality to handle data responsibly and keep respondents' information private.
