



PROCLAMATION

BY THE MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF SAHUARITA, ARIZONA SUSPENDING CERTAIN SIGN CODE PROVISIONS DURING THE COVID-19 LOCAL EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, as Mayor of the Town of Sahuarita, I declared a Local Emergency pursuant to A.R.S. § 26-311 on March 17, 2020, authorizing me to act by proclamation during the emergency; and

WHEREAS, I have determined that, in order to improve the health of our business community and help maintain our local economy, the temporary suspension of certain rules and regulations relating to temporary signs is in the best interest of our community.

IT IS PROCLAIMED AND ORDERED, that regulation of temporary signs, as defined in Sahuarita Town Code 18.79.080 (D), (banner, stake, post, and A-frame or upright signs), and requirements related to temporary off-site sign plans pursuant to Sahuarita Town Code 18.79.060, are hereby suspended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that this Declaration shall remain in full force until a subsequent proclamation or the conclusion of the Local Emergency declared on March 17, 2020.
