Town Reopens Services and Buildings

SAHUARITA, Ariz. — The Town of Sahuarita will reopen all Town services and facilities on Friday, May 8. Town hall will reopen to the public for all counter services such as those conducted in the main lobby, town clerk office; planning and building lobby; and Anamax Recreation Center, although recreational programming may be delayed. Along with reopening, the town will proceed with cautionary measures to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 to ensure a successful reopening. Town employees will be required to observe social distancing and follow CDC guidelines, and those in direct contact with the public will be required to wear a protective mask until further notice.

Sahuarita Police Department will continue to follow safety protocols already in place. Public park amenities in Sahuarita will reopen with the institution of additional cleaning protocols for public common areas such as playground equipment and restrooms.

Mayor Tom Murphy notes that the move comes on the heels of Governor Ducey's Executive order on April 29, "Returning Stronger", allowing retail businesses to reopen May 4 and 8. "We do this cautiously and responsibly with the utmost concern for public health, and for the health of our local businesses, residents and employees," Murphy said. "We're eager to get back to full-capacity service to our residents."

The May 11th Council meeting will be held in the Town Hall Council Chambers and is open to the public.
