New HAWK Crossing Installed



There's a new **High-Intensity Activated crossWalk (HAWK)** crossing on Sahuarita Road, just east of the Union Pacific Railroad crossing. When a pedestrian or cyclist activates the HAWK beacon, drivers will see a series of flashing yellow, yellow, red and flashing red lights to alert them to proceed with caution or come to a full stop. The new HAWK crossing helps to improve safety for pedestrians, cyclists, and smaller pecan farm vehicles.

Rancho Sahuarita Blvd. Paving Alert

In late July, crews will overlay Rancho Sahuarita Blvd., from Sahuarita Road to Avenida Mitla, with **Green Asphalt™**. Its "green" ingredient is recycled tires, allowing the contractor to pave over the existing asphalt with a faster process and a smaller carbon footprint.
