Fiesta Sahuarita to Return in April

SAHUARITA, Ariz. — The Town of Sahuarita’s signature event, Fiesta Sahuarita, will return after a two-year hiatus. This year’s festival will take place on April 23, from 2 to 8 p.m. at Anamax Park and is free and open to the public. The theme for this year’s event will be “A Party in the Desert—Celebrating our Unique Culture and History.” The town is offering the opportunity for vendors to participate in the festivities by hosting a vendor booth. Space for vendors is limited to 100. The fee for reserving a booth is \$50 for one, 10’ x 10’ booth. Sponsorships are also available with levels starting at \$250.

This year’s Fiesta Sahuarita will feature live music, performances, children’s activities, small carnival rides, water slides, bouncing houses, dunk tanks, a roller-skating rink, face painting, arts/crafts, a rope bridge, balloons, and caricature drawings. There will also be a beer and wine garden located on the field hosting the main stage. The town anticipates that 20 to 25 food trucks will participate.

“We’re really excited to have Fiesta Sahuarita back in action,” said Mayor Tom Murphy. “Events like these are such an important part of who we are as a town. They bring us together in a spirit of camaraderie and joy. I’m looking forward to seeing what our hard-working town staff have put together this year.”
