Subject: Sahuarita DUI Task Force Operation

In a joint effort, officers of the Sahuarita Police Department, along with other area law enforcement agencies, participated in a saturation patrol in the area of South-West Tucson and Sahuarita for Cinco de Mayo (May 5<sup>th</sup>). This deployment was paid for with grant funding from The Governor's Office of Highway Safety.

Sahuarita Officers conducted 25 traffic stops. During those stops, two arrests were made for aggravated DUI. Aggravated DUI consists of someone driving impaired while their driver's license is suspended or restricted due to a previous DUI arrest. Two additional separate arrests were made, one for a drug charge and a second for a separate liquor law violation.

- Aaron Carabeo, age 30, from Tucson was arrested for Aggravated DUI during the special operation and booked into the Pima County Jail.
- Jose Apaticio-Reyes, age 51, of Tucson was arrested for Aggravated DUI and Possession of a Narcotic Drug during the special operation and booked into the Pima County Jail.

On average, 10,000 people are killed yearly in DUI related crashes. The Sahuarita Police Department is dedicated to keeping our community safe and committed to holding those who drive impaired accountable.
