- There are rumble strips on northbound and southbound S. Old Nogales Hwy., 500 ft. from the intersection of E. Quail Crossing Blvd.
- Observe traffic signal flashing yellow lights on S. Old Nogales Hwy.
- Observe traffic signal flashing red lights on E. Quail Crossing Blvd.
