Temporary Generator Submittal Checklist

TO BE USED FOR – ALL COMMERCIAL AND RESIDENTIAL UTILITY– PERMIT APPLICATIONS

The following items are required and submittals must be complete before accepted for review.

- Create a user profile online, directions on the website
- Complete all information and submit all of the following required documents on the website
- Plan check fee must be paid for the application to be deemed complete and for the plan review to begin
- Documents must be drawn by an Arizona Licensed Design professional

Upload the following construction in PDF format (only)

- Model Home Address or lot# of generator marked on the enclosure.
- Length of time the Temporary Generator will be used and the daily operation Schedule.
- Site Plan Showing the Location of the generator with linear clearance dimensions.
- Enclosure fence Information (*around generator*) with two Exits. *
- Provide a copy of the generator manufacturer's listing and installation standards. (*must include the following information*):
 - Size of the generator and type of fuel. (*gasoline, diesel, natural gas, LP*)
 - Location of the fuel supply (*same lot as the generator*).
 - Grounding electrode and Bonding information.
- Overcurrent protection (*disconnect*) and Panel /Circuits/ Lugs identified.
- Electrical conductor size, type & burial depth of (*conduit, cords, cables*) and route.
- Generator conductor connection details at the generator and panel. (*include security method at the dwelling SES*).
- "Authorized Personnel Only" Signage.
- "No Smoking" signage.
- "Fire Extinguisher (s)" signage & locations.
- "Temporary Power Only" signage at the dwelling SES.

Note:

- The Town of Sahuarita's Planning and Building Department must approve the Temporary Power Generator Permit and inspect before the generator can be used.
- * Combustible construction materials are permitted if 10' minimum from dwellings/property lines.
